At the start of the week, all members of staff within the ATLP have received 'Attachment and Trauma' training and have had an introduction into 'Emotion' Coaching'. As many of you will be aware, Mrs Franks is an experienced Emotion Coaching Practitioner Trainer. At the end of last term, she appointed ten student peer mentors. These children will begin emotion coaching training next week and will begin supporting their peers during break and lunchtimes. Following this there will be an opportunity to train all children, parents and wider family members. We look forward to embarking on this exciting journey with you.
