Parent feedback and action taken following our parent voice meeting on 26th October.

You said: Communication is not always proactive, and dojos are not always responded to.

We did: We are carrying out a review of our communication approach including the use of Dojo. We will have a clear communication strategy to share with you by the end of January

2024.

You said: We would like extra time at parents evening to discuss our child who has SEND.

We did: We will be allocating additional parent meetings for pupils with SEND in addition to parents evening meetings for Spring and Summer term 2024.

You said: We want more parent workshops, so we know what we can do to support our children.

We did: We have planned workshops for each year group for the remainder of the academic year. Each year group will have a minimum of two workshops throughout the year.

You said: The leaves on the path and EYFS playground are slippy when wet.

We did: We have shared this with our Health and Safety Lead for the Trust. A reasonable solution to this is being sought.

You said: We want to have information available and up to date on the school website. It contains very little information at the moment.

We did: We have carried out a review of our website and will be adding additional information to the pages.

You said; Please focus on writing on paper rather than finger writing on the iPads.

We did: All children have a pencil to use with their iPads.

You said: The path outside nursery/reception floods.

We did: This has been reported to our Operations and Estates Team for further investigation.

You said: Your children raise concerns with you about the cleanliness of the toilets.

We did: We have requested that an additional midday clean is put into place. This has been handed to our Health and Safety Lead to arrange.
