Our Learning

- ❖ To develop our Personal, Social and Emotional skills, we will be focusing on how to follow our class rules and understand why they are important. We will be encouraging children to talk about their feelings and to use talk to solve conflicts.
- ❖ To support our Communication and Language development, we will be listening to longer stories and discussing what has happened. We will also be learning to sing a large repertoire of songs, including songs for a Christmas nativity.
- ❖ In Physical Development, we will be taking part in group activities where we will need to work together as a team. We will continue to develop our riding, balancing and ball skills.
- ❖ In Literacy, we will continue to look at these key concepts about print:
- Print has meaning
- Print can have different purposes
- We read English text from left to right and from top to bottom
- ❖ We will also be looking at our own names and learning to recognise them.
- ❖ In Maths, we will continue to recite numbers and will be practising to count objects by saying one number for each item in order.
- In Understanding the World, we will continue to use our senses to explore a variety of different natural materials. We will be looking at what happens during seasonal changes through our topics of Autumn and Winter.
- In Expressive Arts and Design, we will be exploring different materials freely to develop our ideas about how to use them and what to make. We will continue to use a range of different media such as paint, chalk, wax crayons, clay, sand and glitter to create our own art.

- ❖ In Forest School, we will be continuing to recap the boundaries for Forest Schools and we will also be linking our learning to our reading books such as The Leaf Man, by Lois Elbert and The Gruffalo, by Julia Donaldson.
- ❖ This half term in music we will learn new songs and continue to develop the ways we use our voices. We will use puppets, routine songs and musical instruments. We will explore loud, fast and slow sounds. We are now using Makaton to learn our Nativity songs.
