English

Maths

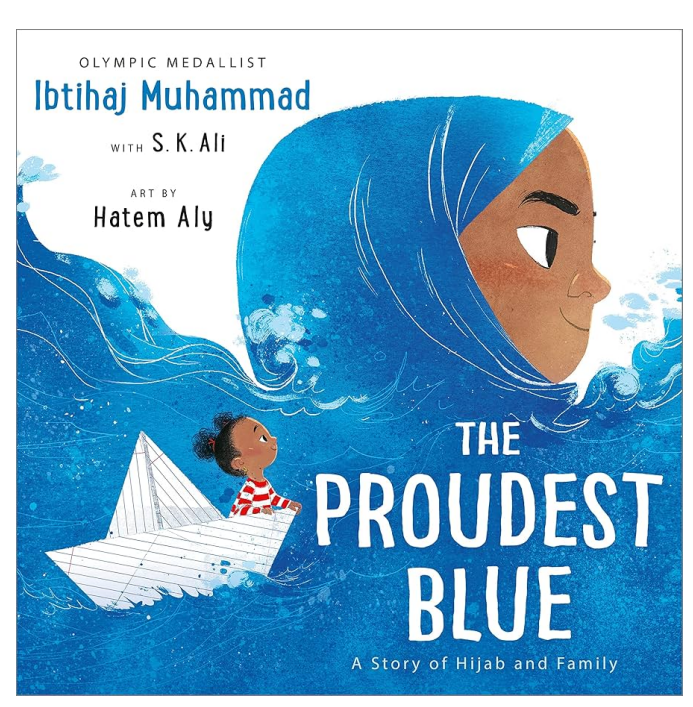
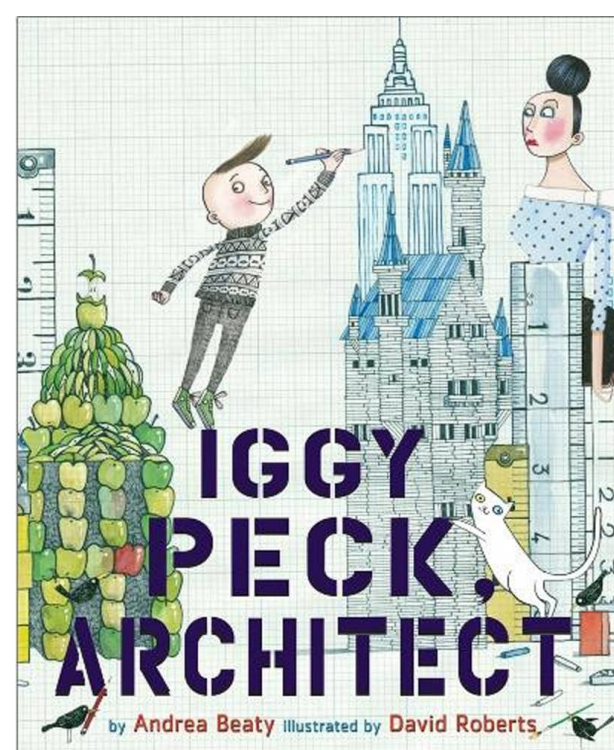
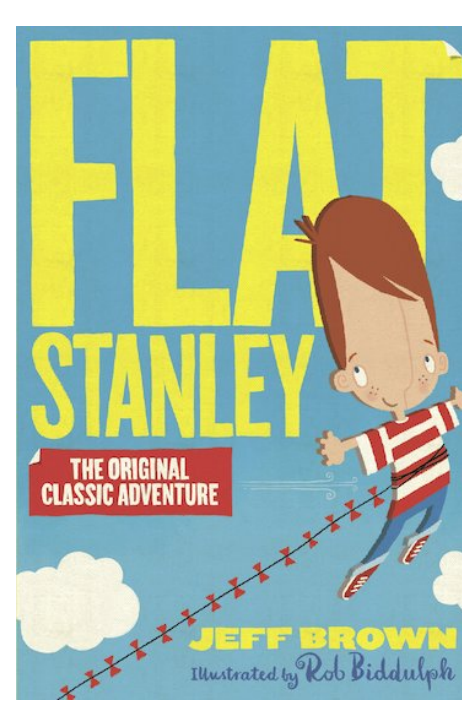
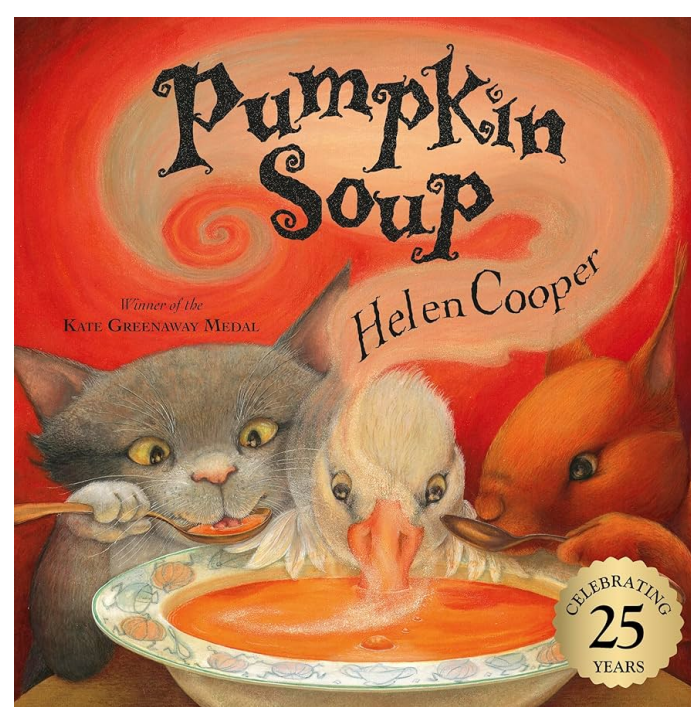
The children will continue to look at addition and subtraction. They will then start to look at shape, which includes 2D and 3D shapes.

Science

This half term in science, the children will study living things and their habitats.

Reading

Reading is at the heart of our curriculum and we take every opportunity within our curriculum to introduce children to stories, texts and vocabulary through a range of genres. We will be reading 'Pumpkin Soup', 'Flat Stanley', 'Iggy Peck, Architect' and 'The Proudest Blue' within our class story time, and exploring other books written by these authors.



Geography

The children will continue to study the continents and oceans of the world.
